Dear Parents/Carer

Thank you for showing an interest in attending our Nursery.

Please complete the online application form (<https://forms.office.com/e/ckyRuN9C8x>) by Monday 19th January 2026. Any application forms received after this date will not be entered into our first round of allocations.

Please note that this application is for admission in September 2026 for children who are born between the dates of 1 September 2022 and 31 August 2023.

All children aged 3/4 are eligible for 15 hours funding per week, however, some children will be eligible for 30 hours per week (extended hour's entitlement). Please see the eligibility criteria below for the additional 15 hours (extended hour's entitlement):

Extended entitlement i.e. an additional 570 hours of 3YO funding

Eligibility criteria: All parents in the family home need to be working the equivalent of 16 hours a week at minimum wage but earning less than £100,000; all applications are made online via Childcare Choices, www.childcarechoices.gov.uk.

Applications for extend hours (30 hours funding) can be made from when your child is 2 years and 36 weeks old. You will need to reconfirm your eligibility every 3 months. If you apply more than 3 months before the term starts, you will have to reconfirm your eligibility in your account in order to keep your code valid. Extended hours codes need to have a start date before the beginning of term, so for September 2024 only codes that started on or before 31st August 2024 will be eligible.

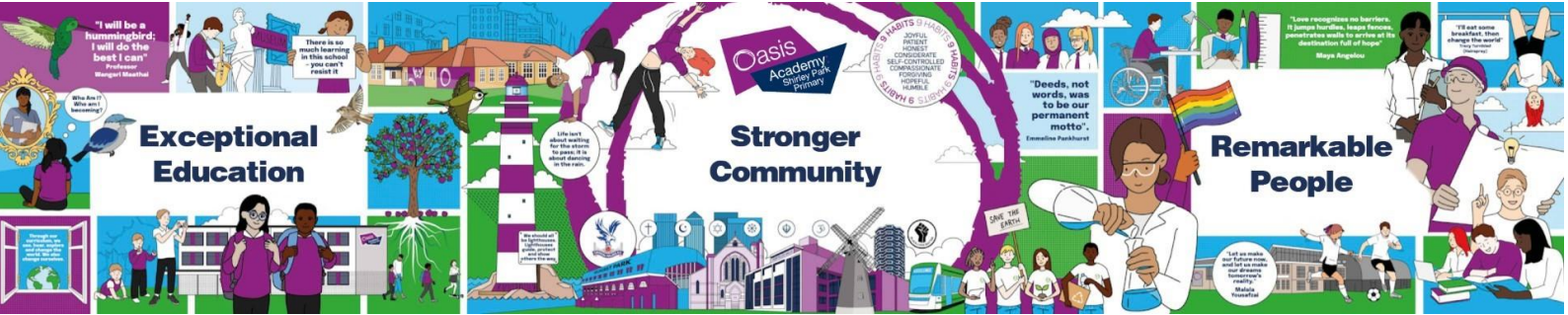
Please note if you apply for a 30 hour Nursery place, these are subject to availability and will be offered according to our admission criteria. It is your responsibility as the parent to provide us with your eligibility code and your national insurance number before your child starts with us in the autumn term. This information can be written on the attached application form or on the parental contract that you will receive in your admission pack should you be successful in being offered a place.
