<p>Sun safety experiment Place coloured paper in sunlight under different materials (foil, tissue, plastic). Children observe which paper fades the quickest. Question prompts: – Which material blocks the most light? the least light? – Why do we wear suncream?</p>	<p>Make fruit ice lollies Children cut fruit, blend, pour into moulds. Literacy link: Write an instruction text using time connectives: <i>First, next, then, finally.</i></p>	<p>Summer senses poem Children to create a simple "Summer Senses Poem": <i>In summer I smell...</i> <i>In summer I hear...</i> <i>In summer I see...</i></p>	<p>Outdoor maths game What you need: Chalk circles or hoops, beanbags How to play: Write numbers inside the circles (e.g., 5, 10, 20). Children throw beanbags and add up their score.</p>
<p>Nature shape hunt What you need: notebook, shape list. How to play: Children search outdoors for items shaped like circles, triangles, cylinders, etc.</p>	<p>Outdoor shape pictures What you need: Sticks, stones, leaves. How to play: Children make pictures (animals, houses, flowers) using outdoor materials in geometric shapes.</p>	<p>Outdoor cinema Many local venues host free events for families in the evenings during summer. Pack a blanket and some snacks and enjoy an evening outdoors enjoying the show! https://freefilmfestivals.org</p>	<p>Minibeast survey Skills: Observing, recording, tally charts Activity: Children explore a garden area with magnifiers. Record how many insects they find and compare results</p>
